




### The Power to Collect Taxes


- American Revolution caused debt
- Tax was necessary to pay debt
- Article 1, Section 8 of the U.S. Constitution granted Congress power to tax




The U.S. Constitution gives Congress power to collect taxes



#### The Federal Government Dollar- Where It Comes From




#### The Federal Government Dollar – Where It Goes
